KPFK 90.7 FM Los Angeles Presents Joyce Riley and the Award-Winning Documentary Beyond Treason

KPFK 90.7 FM Los Angeles/98.7FM Santa Barbara, non-commercial listener-sponsored community radio since 1959, will present Joyce Riley, nationally recognized spokesperson for Gulf War Veterans Association (GWVA) in a special commemoration of Veterans Day, on Friday, November 11 at 7pm at Immanuel Presbyterian Church, 3300 Wilshire Blvd and will feature a screening of the award-winning documentary **Beyond Treason**, exposing the U.S. government's long history of experimentation on military troops.

Co-host of the daily morning talk radio show *The Power Hour* on Genesis Radio, Joyce Riley served as a Captain in the United States Air Force and flew on C-130 missions in support of Operation Desert Storm. The Gulf War Veterans Association provides education and information for Gulf War veterans and their families and seeks treatment for the illnesses from which thousands of Gulf War veterans now suffer. Recently, Riley has campaigned to stop the illegal use of depleted uranium on the battlefield, pointing out its debilitating effects on troops and civilians exposed to high levels of radiation.

Once a committed and dedicated military service member, Riley, seeking to understand her own illness resulting from Gulf war vaccinations, uncovered research and government documents detailing the medical and scientific experimentation over 50 years on hundreds of thousands of military personnel without their fundamental knowledge or consent. Beginning in 1996, Riley mounted a media campaign to inform veterans and their families and to bring public and congressional attention to the alarming numbers of veterans affected by what recent government and Pentagon officials call a "mystery illness."

Riley's campaign brought her in contact with William Lewis and led to her participation in the film **Beyond Treason**, a documentary thoroughly analyzing the depleted uranium problem and the government's lack of concern about hundreds of thousands of sick and dying troops as well as civilians. The evening with Joyce Riley will begin with a screening of **Beyond Treason** at 7pm. Riley will speak following the film and respond to audience Q & A. Copies of the documentary will be available at the event.

General admission tickets are \$25 donation per person or \$40.00 for two tickets to be paid at the door. For this special screening on Veteran's Day, veterans with military I.D. will be honored with free admission at the door. Students and seniors are half-price and children under 12 will also be admitted free accompanied by an adult. No one will be turned away for lack of funds. Free Parking is available across the street from Immanuel Presbyterian Church in the UTLA Parking facility, off Berendo St., north of Wilshire Boulevard or street parking.
